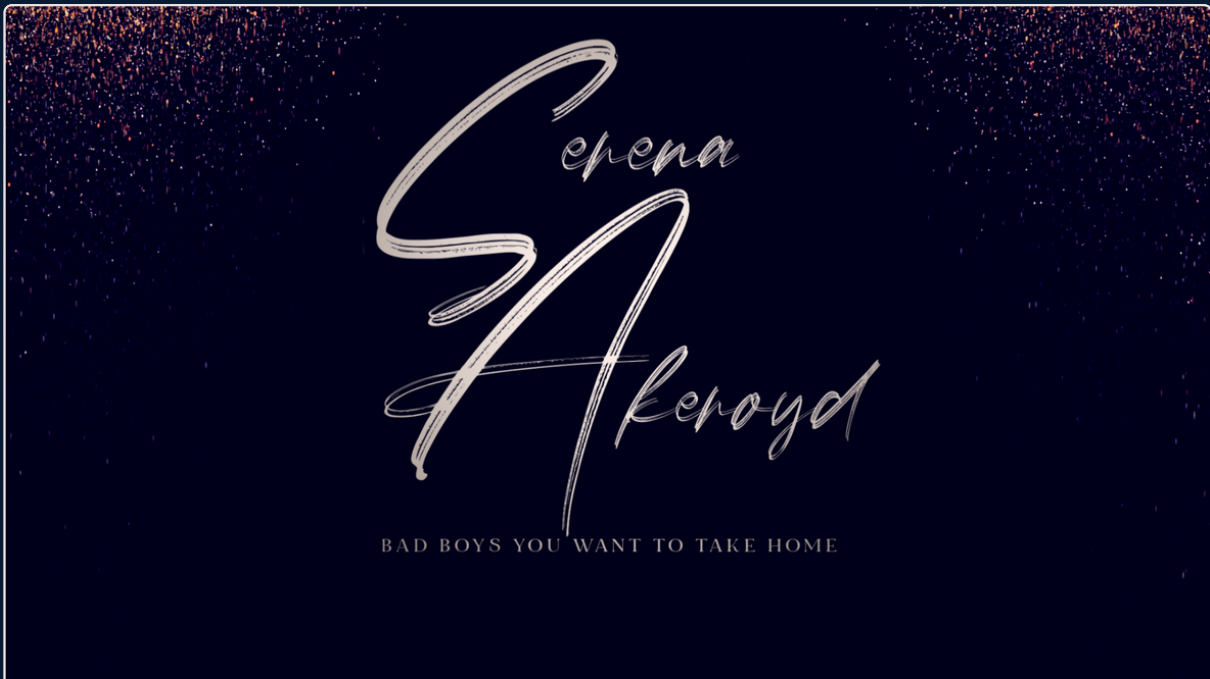
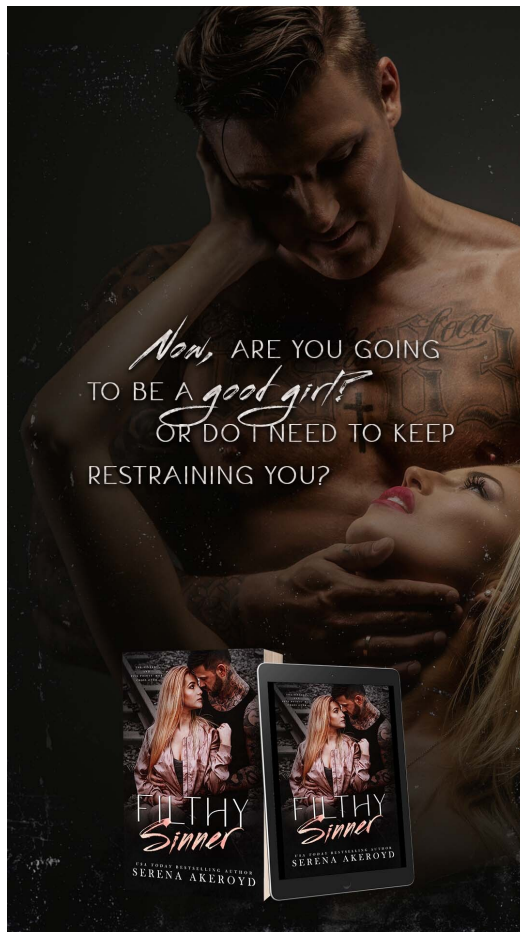

Hello Lovelies!

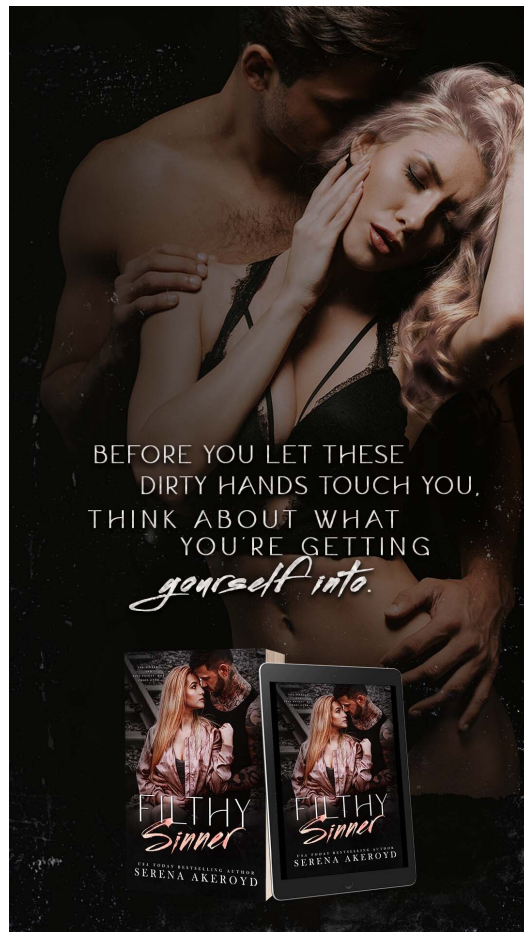
I'm hearing through the grapevine that, for many of you, the book hangover from the Filthy Feck Duet is brutal. That moving on from this family we love is hard...

Perhaps that was why he caught my eye, though, and why I couldn't stop staring as I walked down the street to my house.

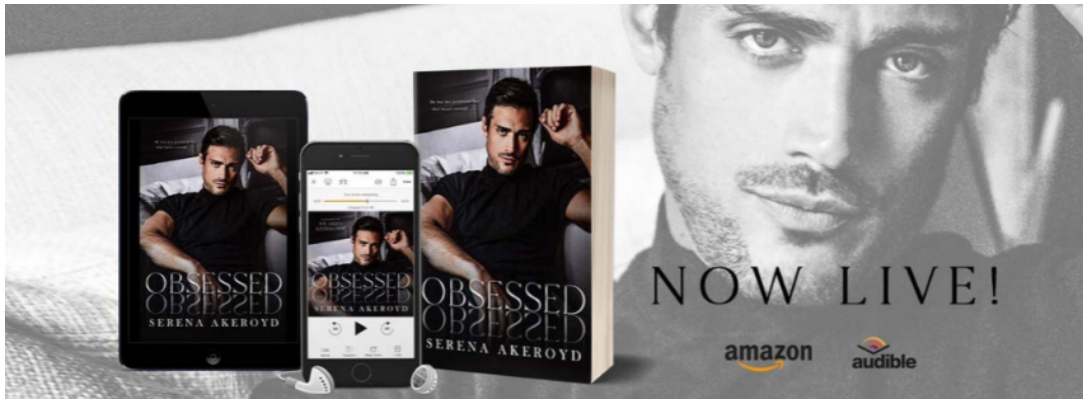
